Our grand ballroom can accommodate up to 300. Ideal for more significant ceremonies, the area may be divided into portions for more intimate gatherings.



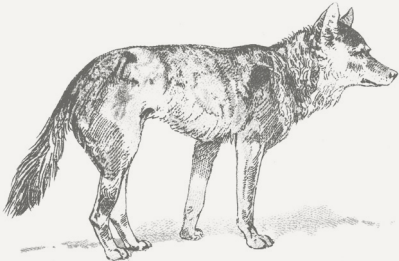






# WOLF CREEK BAR & GRILL
